Subject: - Daily availability of Observers to redress the grievances, complaint etc

Ref. Instructions given during Observers' briefing dated 11<sup>th</sup> /12<sup>th</sup> September, 2009.

Sir,

In order to ensure that the observers sent by the Election Commission of India with regard to the ongoing General Election to the State Legislative Assembly of Arunachal Pradesh are available for listening to, and for ensuring proper and timely redressal of grievances, complaints etc., if any, from general public, political parties etc., the following may please be immediately ensured: -

The Observer should ensure his/her availability at the decided location & duration except for such occasions when it does not remain possible for reasons of compelling and immediate nature, which should be mentioned date-wise by the Observer in his report. (The time slot and location should be well publicized through local newspapers etc.)

Since the areas assigned to individual Observers in Arunachal Pradesh may be very large, the Observers should try and work out the above arrangement to the extent possible depending on the location of the Observers and the distances involved. The deviation, that is, the instances (with reasons) where the above instructions cannot be complied with, should be mentioned date-wise in the reports of the Observers.

The above instructions are being loaded on the observers' portal on the Election Commission of India website <http://eci.nic.in>. The Chief Electoral Officer is requested to make them available on parallel basis immediately to all the observers deployed in Arunachal Pradesh.
