Subject: General Election to Gujarat Legislative Assembly, 2007—  
**Commission's Order regarding use of EPICs** - Regarding.

Sir,

In continuation of the Commission's letter No. 3/4/ID/2007/J.S.II/(GUJ), dated 7<sup>th</sup> December 2007 forwarding therewith its Order of even No. dated 7<sup>th</sup> December 2007, on the subject cited, I am directed to state that it has been brought to the notice of the Commission that the EPIC number of electors may have been reflected in the second supplement of **continuous updation** of electoral roll but such EPICs may not have actually been delivered to the electors concerned. The Commission has directed that in case where EPICs have been prepared and particulars thereof have been reflected in the second and third supplement of electoral roll but not actually delivered to the electors concerned, in such case the said electors may be allowed to cast their votes on producing any one of the alternative documents as provided in the Commission's Order referred to above.

2. It may please be noted that this exception is available for only such electors who are in supplement No. 2 and supplement No. 3 containing the list of electors included after the final publication of rolls on 23.07.2007 and limited to voters issued with EPIC but not distributed actually.

3. This shall be brought to the notice of the District Election Officers/Returning Officers/Asstt. Returning Officers/Observers/Micro Observers/Presiding Officers and all other election related officers immediately for their compliance.
