Sub: General election to Legislative Assembly of Gujarat, 2007 – Treatment of vehicles pasted with stickers & pamphlets – Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. ELC-2907-12305-CHH, dated 6th December 2007 on the above matter. The following course of action may be taken:

The stickers pasted on the vehicles without the knowledge of the owner of the vehicle may be got removed. If pasting of stickers on the vehicles is done by or with the knowledge of owner of the vehicle, then the following action may be taken:

- (i) if, it is done without the written authority from the candidate, it should be examined whether Section 171H of the IPC is attracted, and if so action should be taken under that Section, against the owner of the vehicle.
- (ii) If the pasting of sticker is done with the written authority from the candidate, expenses incurred on the vehicle should be booked to the account of the candidate.

The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned as well as to the contesting candidates for compliance.
