**Commission's Order regarding use of EPICs** - Regarding.

Sir,

In continuation of the Commission's letter No. 3/4/ID/2007/J.S.II/(GUJ), dated 7<sup>th</sup> December 2007 forwarding therewith its Order of even No. dated 7<sup>th</sup> December 2007, on the subject cited, I am directed to state that it has been brought to the notice of the Commission that the EPIC number of electors may have been reflected in the supplements of **continuous updation** of electoral roll but such EPICs may not have actually been delivered to the electors concerned.

2. The Commission has directed that for such cases, the DEOs shall get a separate list prepared with relevant particulars and provide it to the Presiding Officers. If any voter from this list appear on the poll day for casting his/her vote, then the voter can be allowed to vote on any of the alternative documents approved by the Commission.

3. This shall be brought to the notice of the District Election Officers/Returning Officers/Asstt. Returning Officers/Observers/Micro Observers/Presiding Officers and all other election related officers immediately for their compliance.
