
Subject:- Recognition of '**Rashtriya Lok Samta Party**' as a State Party in **Bihar**-regarding.

I am directed to state that on the basis of review of poll performance of '**Rashtriya Lok Samta Party**' at the general election to the Lok Sabha, 2014, it is seen that the '**Rashtriya Lok Samta Party**', presently, a registered un-recognised party, has fulfilled the conditions laid down in Para 6A of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, for recognition as a State party in the State of **Bihar**. Accordingly, the Commission has decided to recognize the '**Rashtriya Lok Samta Party**' as a State party in the State of **Bihar** under the provisions of the Election Symbols (Reservation & Allotment) Order, 1968.

2. The party may intimate its choice of symbol to be allotted as the reserved symbol of the party as a State Party in the State of **Bihar**, immediately.
